To be effective

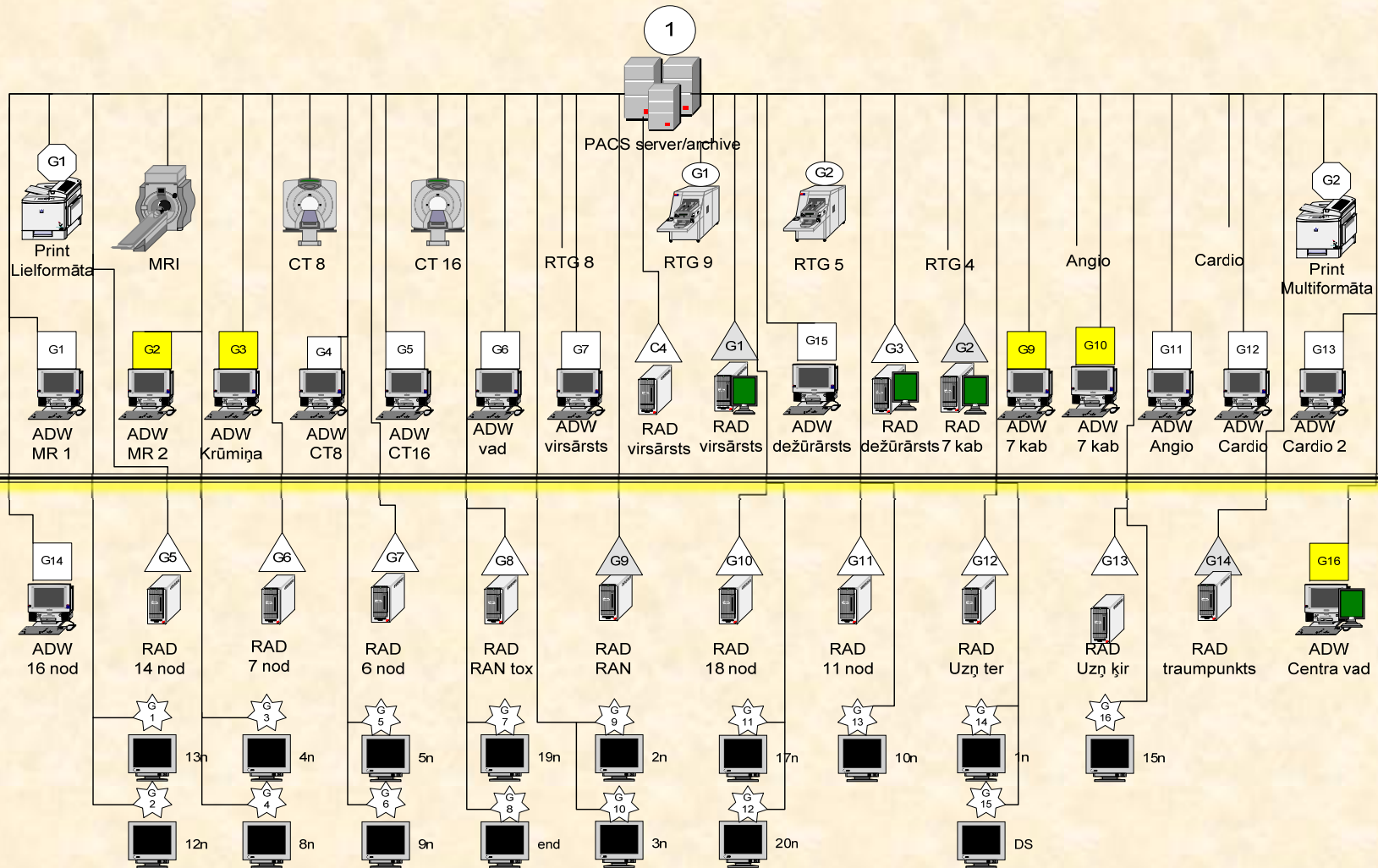
1. Finances

First steps after merging

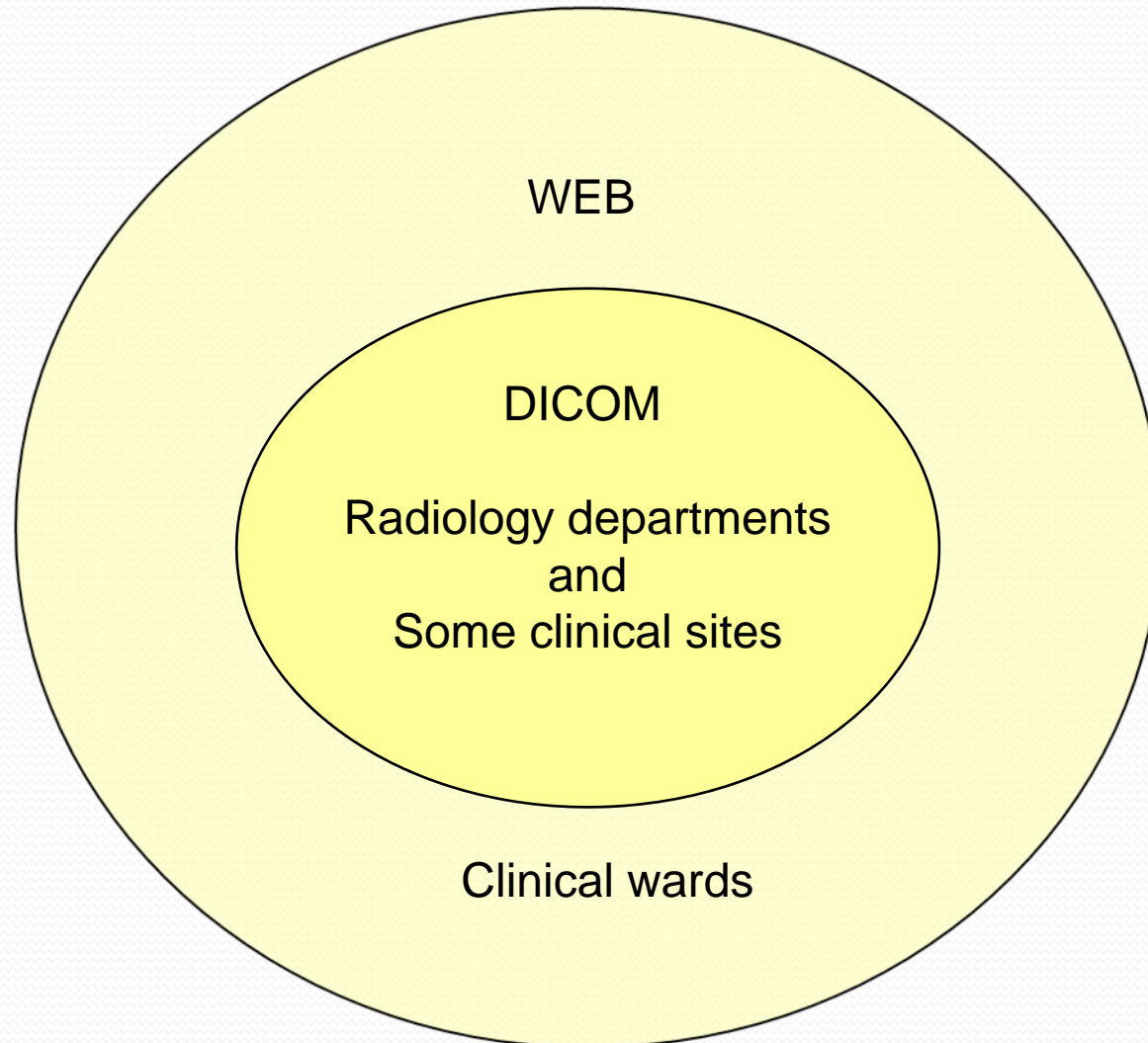
1. To estimate the current situation
